Minutes

Of the meeting held on the 17 May 2023 held at South Charlton Village Hall following the AGM

1. Election of Officials:

- a. Chairman Lorna Turner was retained. Proposed by JA, Seconded by AM
- b. Vice Chair Joanne Angus was retained. Proposed by AM, Seconded by JS
- 2. Public participation: none
- 3. Apologies for absence: Jamie Logan (JLo), Clair Leishman (CL)
- 4. **Minutes of the previous meeting:** To consider approval or amendment of the minutes from the previous parish council meeting 5 Apr 2023. The minutes were agreed and approved.
- 5. **Declaration of interest:** none declared at the outset of the meeting.
- 6. Matters Arising:
 - Verge Issue in Eglingham JS has spoken to the resident whose property it relates.
 LT asked if the long standing matter could be integrated into further discussions around long term village maintenance.
 - b. Bin Relocation, Eglingham JA updated after contact with NCC. NCC is to fix the bin to the Give Way sign once bushes were cut back.
 - c. Drone Photo of Community Field No update
 - d. Biodiversity Project Again, an extensive discussion was held based on legal arguments around the specific need for authorities as minor as Parish Councils needing to have biodiversity policies. JH presented a Gov document stating local authorities had "a duty to enhance & preserve" and an example of a PC in the south of England that had a policy.
 - It was noted that the PC had received, via JH, written agreement from three landowners originally surveyed for their parts of the final report to be published. A vote was taken on whether to carry through the project to Phase 3 for these three landowners. The vote passed with 5 for and 2 abstentions.
 - JH to contact EcoNorth to complete Phase 3
 - e. South Charlton Noticeboard Deferredf. Street Lighting in Eglingham Deferred
 - g. Mini Library/Book swap Deferred
 - h. Charles III Coronation Commemorative Tree JH had investigated costs for the proposal. A 2 year old Oak tree £25 and plaque approx. £150. To be discussed further before the next planting season ends.
 - Charles III Coronation Events. JH reported on successful events held in all 3 villages. £373 had been secured from the windfarm fund. Approx 40 people attended in Eglingham, 35 in South Charlton and 6 at North Charlton.
